Agenda:

1. Introduced new council members and visitors
2. Voted to keep Chair and Co-Chair as 2 year positions leaving Amber Sloan and Jenn Price as Chair and Co-Chair respectively
3. Approved minutes from March 9, 2017
4. Approved SCC Schedule for 2017-18
5. Discussed bus permits and made decisions on permits. All permits requested for bus 1090 were approved (21 requests, 30 available seats). 20 permits for bus 1281 were approved (only 22 seats available) and 22 permits were not approved due to limited seats. Permits were issued to families further away from the school. Also, concern about bus stops and traffic was brought up. Mrs. Bona and Mr. Yospe will try to visit all stops and talk to kids about safety. Mr. Young and Mr. Robinson will talk to transportation about a safer location for the stop at Zuni and Geronimo.
6. Shared Professional Development slated for 2017-18. Midas Creek has the unique opportunity to have a full staff training on Comprehensive Math Instruction (CMI) with BYU. About 2 times a month, all teachers will receive 2 hours of training. They have already participated in 2 full days before school started. CMI is not a curriculum, but rather a way to change instruction to allow students more opportunities to solve problems, share ideas, and be more engaged in math.
7. Shared Lexia Data. We are very proud of our achievement with this Technology grant. We started the year with 60% of students below grade level on reading skills and 40% on grade level. At the end of the year, we had only 10% below, 37% on level and 53% above grade level.
