3. Shared expenditures and outcomes from 2016-17 Land Trust
4. Shared school grade (B, 408/600 points with 414 needed for an A), proficiency and growth from SAGE and DIBELS results from 2016-17
  - a. ELA-proficiency 55.6 (11<sup>th</sup> of 20 comparative schools (3<sup>rd</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> were within 5 percentage points) and growth 3<sup>rd</sup> of 20 comparative schools at 60<sup>th</sup> percentile.
  - b. Math- proficiency 64% (5<sup>th</sup> of 20 comparative schools and growth 1<sup>st</sup> of 20 comparative schools at 68<sup>th</sup> percentile.
  - c. Science- proficiency 62% (8<sup>th</sup> of 20 comparative schools and growth 7<sup>th</sup> of 20 comparative schools at 55<sup>th</sup> percentile.
5. Discussed spending SCC Account balance from fundraising several years ago for technology \$13,158.23 to purchase 87 Chrome Books. We are working to get 3<sup>rd</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> at a one-one computer to student ratio.
6. Shared progress with Professional Development-CMI and Language Arts. Our school has a unique opportunity for the coming year. As part of our BYU partnership, we have been offered the chance to have all of our teachers trained in Comprehensive Mathematics Instruction (CMI). During the year, teachers will participate in 2-hour training sessions. This is not a new curriculum, but rather a better way to approach the math curriculum we already teach. Teachers will also participate in 3 half day professional development days in language arts as a feeder system.
7. Halloween: Discussed Halloween parade with increased participation from kids and students. Last year was crowded with ABC tracks. This year we will have all students. We would like to try holding the parade outside and encourage parents to dress for the weather and bring their own camping stools or stand.
