Consequences for Not Following Midas Creek Rules

 - Communicate concerns with parents or guardians.

• Most situations can be resolved by working together (students, teachers, parents, and administrators). In the event of significant behavior (disruptive behavior, fighting, persistent inappropriate language or disrespect of students or staff, bullying, etc.) students may be given a lunch detention, in-school suspension, or suspension out of *school. Please see student conduct policy for additional areas of concern.*

Reporting Process

• Students are advised to notify teacher(s) or administrator(s) with concerns. Midas Creek strives to ensure that all students are safe while at school. Students are encouraged to fill out a statement to document the concern.

• Parents are encouraged to communicate concerns with teachers or administrators.

• Midas Creek strives to follow district policy regarding bullying and cyber-bullying. Parents and students should report any incidents to the classroom teacher first, then to administration.

Education Process for Students, Parents, Faculty, and Staff

- Students receive instruction on Midas Creek Rules at the beginning of each school year and throughout the year as needed. One student per class is selected monthly for our Student Leadership Event. Emphasizing and recognizing the positive things students are doing in school builds community and encourages students to enjoy school.
- Faculty and staff receive training on Midas Creek Rules at the beginning of each school year.
